## Statement on International Women's Day | March 8, 2021

For Our Fight for Gender Equality, Justice, and Peace

On International Women's Day, we honor the women who have fought for gender equality, justice, and peace throughout our history. Boldly and bravely, these women have fought for our rights to be respected, justice to be served, and our future generations to turn hate into compassion.
