OPEN LETTER TO

Dear Mr. President,

We the undersigned student unions congratulate on your G-20 Presidency and welcome your Chairmanship of ASEAN which will commence in January 2023. We very much look forward to your leadership of ASEAN in a time when global political rifts are unceasingly intense with critical implications for the region and contentious regional issues, which include the coup d'état in Myanmar last year and continued atrocities of the Myanmar military, are in need of multilateral responses that will not fail.

We are certain that Mr. President is aware that on November 30th 2022, the military court of Insein Prison sentenced 11 youths including 7 university students to death: Thet Paing Oo, Thiha Htet Zaw, Khant Lin Maung Maung, Thura Maung Maung, Khant Zin Win, Hein Htet and Zaw Lin Naing.

With the prior execution of four pro-democracy activists and members of Myanmar's democratic opposition, including Kyaw Min Yu and Zeyar Thaw, the junta set a grim precedent by carrying out the execution of the political prisoners who had been given the death penalty. Needless to say, handing out death sentences with a lack of proper judicial proceedings is just one of the junta's modes of suppressing democracy and freedom of expression, along with extrajudicial killings, torture, arson and looting.

In July, the military ignored calls from ASEAN and the wider international community to commute the sentences of four late members of the opposition. Instead, the military proceeded with executions, effectively sabotaging ASEAN's credibility in its international response to the Myanmar coup. Now, the court ruling on November 30th is yet another example of the military's disregard for cooperation, which undermines the intent of ASEAN's 5-point consensus and the spirit of the ASEAN Charter. Consequently, ASEAN failed in its attempts through diplomacy to save four lives and it failed the people of Myanmar too.

Twenty months after the adoption of ASEAN's 5-point consensus, with ever increasing pressure on ASEAN's leadership in the international response, the appeasement policy towards the junta has been proven unproductive. Thousands of people have lost their lives to the junta's brutality since April last year when the consensus was adopted and each were the members of ASEAN community. Today Myanmar is becoming a killing field where the military junta is intentionally targeting civilians including childrens all over the country. The death penalty of 7 students is just a tip of the iceberg of all crimes and atrocities committed by the junta in Myanmar. This has to be stopped and the military must not proceed with

executing these 7 activists. Towards this end, we appeal to you Mr. President, as the incoming Chairman of the ASEAN, regarding the following points:

- ASEAN should pressure the junta by every possible means to commute these death sentences, to
 release all the political prisoners to stop arbitary arrests of the activists and members of democratic
 constitution and to abolish the death penalty for members of the opposition, which are unacceptable
 in the first place and in conflict with the ASEAN Charter.
- In doing so, ASEAN should pose a credible penalty on the junta which is to be carried out should the junta fail to comply. Repeated ignorance of cooperation must not be tolerated since it could undermine ASEAN's credibility in this time of contentious global politics.
- 3. Should the junta proceed with the executions or continue to perpetrate such heinous crimes against the people of Myanmar, the ASEAN's responses embodied by the 5-point consensus should be considered to be in need of complete reform. To facilitate this, contact with all the parties concerned including the National Unity Government, the National Unity Consultative Council and ethnic resistance organizations should be initiated as soon as possible.

Please accept, Mr. President, the assurance of our highest consideration. We wish you all the best with your ASEAN Chairmanship in 2023.
