An appeal to the international community in relation to the mass murder committed by the terrorist military junta at Pazigyi Village and other areas of the country.

 The following is the statement of condemnation issued by Pa-O National Federal Council (PNFC) on 25th October 2022 to the bombing air raid on a celebratory public event held at A Nang Pa:

The terrorist military junta is committing war crimes such as the A Nang Pa incident and Let Yet Kone incident daily and is trying to cover up one war crime by perpetrating another war crime. It is Pa-O National Federal Council's (PNFC) belief that to hold the terrorist military council accountable for the mass murder at A Nang Pa and LetYet Kone will need international engagement but to rid the country of dictatorships, including military dictatorship is a national obligation.

- As described in this statement, other mass murders followed in many parts of the country; Nam Nein Village in Pa-O area as well as areas in Chin State, Karen State, Karenni and Shan States, Sagaing Division and Magway Division.
- 3. The heinous bombing air raids on 10th April 2023 on Wai Bula high school in Falam Township, Chin State and on 11th April 2023 on Pazigyi Village, Kantabalu Township, Sagaing Division, killing hundreds of innocent civilians including children are not going to be the last. We, Pa-O National Federal Council (PNFC) strongly believe that the mass slaughter will continue all over Myanmar in the future.
- 4. We would like to inform and warn the international community that just by denouncing the brutal slaughter of innocent civilians by the terrorist fascist army is not going to prevent further atrocities.
- 5. We understand that there are differences of opinions and views while considering Myanmar's political problems and woes. But we believe that despite these differences, there is a common factor that the international community should all agree on, is the fact the terrorist military junta is a neofascist group that will not stop at mass murder and so the junta should be held accountable for the crimes committed by their subordinates.
- 6. We, therefore, urge the international community that even if a common solution cannot be found to solve all of Myanmar's political crisis, the common goal should be a practical approach to stop the fascist military junta from perpetrating this mass execution of innocent civilians by any means possible and see that justice is served.
