

Young boy killed, two elderly women injured by SAC air and artillery attacks in Pruso and Bawlake townships

An 8-year-old boy was killed and two elderly women injured by indiscriminate SAC air and artillery attacks on villages in Pruso and Bawlake townships during the past two weeks, as SAC troops continued to attempt to clear resistance forces away from their supply lines down to Mese in southeast Karenni State.

On September 27, SAC troops carrying out operations near Htar Le village clashed with KNDF-05 in Pruso township. A chief of operations from KNDF was killed in the clash.

On September 29, SAC troops who had set up an outpost on the mountain of Settaw Yar, near Moebye town, Southern Shan State, were ambushed and attacked by snipers of the Moebye People's Defence Force. One SAC soldier was killed and one injured.

On October 4, at 6 am, SAC troops carrying out an offensive near Khon Ha village, Pasaung township, clashed with combined Karenni forces; 5 SAC soldiers including a captain were killed in the clash. On the same day, at 10 pm, a fighter jet dropped two bombs in eastern Pruso township, damaging three houses, three school classroom buildings and one teachers' building. After the bombing, the school was temporarily closed and civilians fled into nearby jungle.

On October 5, SAC troops at the Pruso-based no.14 military training school indiscriminately fired artillery shells into a village east of Pruso township, injuring a 50-year-old woman in her head and back, and killing one cow. Moreover, at 10 pm, the same SAC troops indiscriminately fired 10 more shells into civilian areas east of Pruso township.

On October 6, at 11:30 am, despite there being no fighting at the time, a SAC fighter jet bombed Nam Kwee Khu village, Bawlake township, injuring an elderly woman. On the same day, at 10 pm, SAC troops at the Pruso-based no. 14 military training school fired 15 artillery shells into two villages in Pruso township, damaging five houses, killing two cows, and injuring a cow and two buffalos.

On October 7, at 1 pm, SAC troops at the no. 14 military training school fired artillery shells into a village in western Pruso township, killing an 8-year-old boy and damaging two houses. On the same day, at 6 pm, SAC troops at the no. 14 military training school indiscriminately fired five shells again into a village, damaging six houses.
