## Women's Information Factsheet May 2024

It has been more than three years since the military terrorist attempted the coup on 1st February 2021; the people of Myanmar are still against the dictatorial system with various forms of resistance like non-violent ways as well as armed revolution. Women are being killed every day due to grave human rights violations committed by military terrorist. Thus, the presented data are monitored and collected on reliable media by the Burmese Women's Union (BWU). The actual figures could be higher on the ground due to the challenges and limitations of free-flow information, as BWU faces numerous obstacles and challenges in accessing data and information.

Due to BWU's data monitoring from various reliable medias, (41) women were killed from 1st -27th May 2024 across the country. Among them (16) women lost their lives due to military artillery shelling targeting civilian homes and villages, (14) women died in the military airstrike, (8) were killed by the military without reason, (1) died due to stepping landmine, (1) woman was raped and killed by Pyu Saw Htee, and (1) was raped and killed by the civilians respectively. Among (41) women fatalities, BWU found that (8) were teenagers under 18 years. In addition, (27) were wounded; among them, (12) were by military artillery shelling, (3) were due to aerial bombardment by the military, (7) were due to landmines, and (5) were because of the remaining mine explosion.



Number of women Fatality by Regions and States

In accordance with the media data collected by BWU, the number of women fatalities was (9) from Sagaing region, (8) from Magway, and (7) from Rakhine state, respectively; Sagaing region is the highest number of women deaths in May.

## Number of Women Detainees by Regions



Based on the BWU's data monitoring, (10) women were arrested across the country. Out of them, (9) were arrested by the military terrorist, and (1) was arrested by the Myanmar National Democratic Alliance Army (MNDAA). Among arrested women, (2) from Octopus organization were violently beaten and arrested due to non-violent protests the military. According to Assistance Association for Political Prisoners (AAPP) data, (5,517) women have been arrested since the military attempted coup on 29th May 2024. The number of women arrested could be higher on the ground. Note: The actual figures could be much higher on the ground as there are challenges in information flow and obstacles to accessing them.
